

## TUG OF WAR- NAM GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. All participants must be registered NAM members.
2. One team can be registered with 10 participants with one captain and a manager. These 10 participants cannot be changed including the final.
3. Only 7 players will be participating at a time, substitutes whose names are registered at the beginning, can be used in each game.
4. All the team must be pre-registered for the tournament with the fees and all the team members have to sign the disclaimer.
5. Footwear: - No metal spikes. Rubber spikes shoes can be used.
6. Referee – there will be 1 main impartial referee and 2 assistant referees. Their decision will be final. When there is conflict arises, only captain can appeal with the committee and committee along with referees to make final decision.
7. Vadam will be provided by NAM.
8. All team must be reported, and all team members must be signed the disclaimer by 14:00 hrs on the day of the event.

Fixture template as follows:-

Team C x Team D.

6 x 3 = 18 Tug of war matches.

- All 18 matches must be done and each point will be calculated. Top two teams will go to final which will be on 13<sup>th</sup> September 10am.
- If the points are equal, look for the most matches won. If this is also same, then will look for which team won when they compete each other.
- If all these conditions are still equal again compete each other once more and it will be sudden death (only one final pull), meaning whoever wins will be the champions.
